Preventive dentistry, Paediatric dentistry and orthodontics are supposed to be the corner stones of dental profession. Paediatric dentistry is synonymous with dentistry for children. It exist because children have dental and orofacial problems like dental decay, inflammation and pain associated with infected pulpal tissue and suppuration in alveolar bone.
